EFFECTIVE USE OF TECHNOLOGY IN TEACHING

FULL DESCRIPTION OF TRAINING CONTENT

This course is for teachers who would like to increase their awareness and usage of technology in a teaching context. Morning sessions focus on language development where participants gain confidence in using English. The afternoon methodology sessions introduce fresh and communicative approaches to using technology in teaching

PREPARATION

All participants complete a pre-registration form with the following information:

- Current teaching role and responsibilities
- Previous professional development
- Age of students
- Teaching experience
- Reasons for choosing the course

OBJECTIVES

By experiencing a range of practical teaching techniques, participants will expand their own working classroom ideas while refreshing and developing their English language proficiency.

By the end of the course participants will have:

- Collected a portfolio of teaching resources
- Acquired new ideas for motivating their students
- Increased their awareness of how technology can be used in the classroom
- Shared ideas and experiences
- Increased awareness of how cultural backgrounds can affect classroom dynamics
- Created a network of teaching contacts within Europe



METHODOLOGY

This course uses a wide variety of communicative activities to develop language competence and will also raise participants' awareness of how technology can be used in the classroom. Participants gain confidence in using technology through practical sessions which equip them with ideas and materials that they can use upon their return to their own country. They will take part in seminars, workshops, lectures, open discussions and a study visit during term time (e.g. a primary school, a secondary school, an FE college or a training and enterprise organization) or a place of cultural interest (non-term time). The exact content of the course is negotiated before and throughout the course to take into account the specific needs and developing interests of each group.

Participants are grouped according to their English level for morning language development sessions and are encouraged to reflect on how they could adapt the activities done in lessons for use in their own classrooms. Afternoon methodology sessions are grouped according to teaching context.

30 Seconds Talk



- 1. Speak English as much as possible outside the class to your classmates, even if they're the same nationality
- 2. Talk to your host family as much as possible & make notes of any new words/expressions
- 3. Give someone in your host family a lesson in your language in return for a free English lesson!
- 4. Keep a personal diary in English
- 5. Go to the study room (room 3) and borrow some readers for extra practice
- 6. Read everything! Newspapers, magazines, adverts, street signs...
- 7. Listen to other people's conversations on the bus or train or in shops and write down any interesting expressions...
- 8. Watch English TV, go to the cinema and theatre, listen to the radio. It doesn't matter if you don't understand everything, you'll improve quickly!
- 9. Try to make conversation wherever you are, in shops, in the pub, at the disco....
- 10. Join a gym, play pool, go to evening classes, go to places where English people meet. Ask at reception for information.
- 11. Get on the Internet on your laptop or in the computer room (room 11) in the afternoons and use websites to improve your English. Some useful websites are:
